## Tasting



### *Teres Red*

*Red wine, with cherry reflections.*

*Aromas of red fruit. Well balanced on the palate, with spicy notes.*



### *Teres Rosé*

*A crystal coloured rosé, with beautiful, pale reflections of pink. Small fresh fruits on the nose.*

*On the palate light and supple. Fresh rosé.*



### *Teres White*

*On the nose, aromas of citrus fruit blossoms.*

*Notes of fruit, fresh and round on the palate. Full, well balanced.*
